

## Adam McLean - Man of the meeting - 2018

McLean, who made his road race debut at the Cookstown 100 in 2015, finishing third in the Junior Support race, notched up 76 points in the scoring system, based on the Championship races run yesterday.



Fifth in the Open A race, followed by a second in the Moto 3 class, second in the Supersport 600 race, before taking a well deserved win in the Supertwin race was enough to give the McAdoo Racing/Hanna Motors rider the coveted Man of the Meeting award for 2018.
