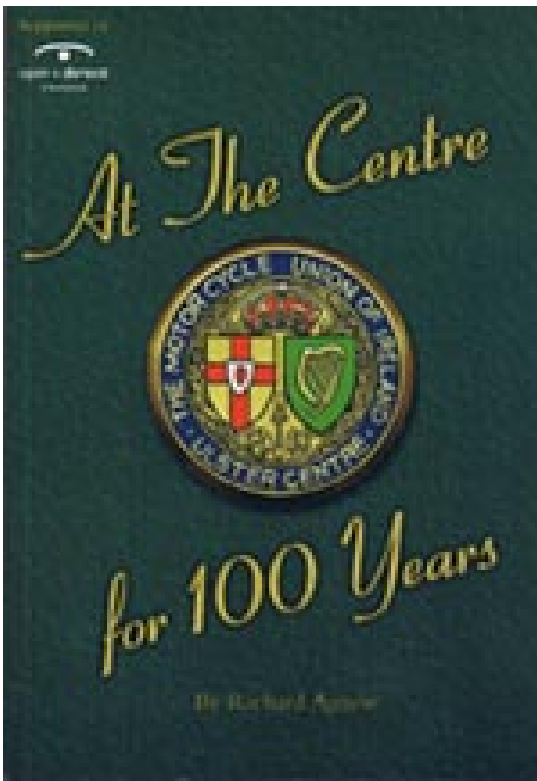


MCUI(UC) History:

Founded in January 1903, the Motor Cycle Union of Ireland (Ulster Centre) is the governing body for Road Racing, Short Circuits and Trials within the 9 counties of Ulster.

Today the Ulster Centre consists of 27 affiliated clubs/bodies which, together with a number of appointed officials, form the Council of the Centre. The Council meets on the first Monday of each month in the Chimney Corner Hotel, Newtownabbey, Belfast at 7.30pm. The Business of the Centre is conducted by a number of specialist committees appointed by the Council at the Annual General Meeting. Two of the central bodies are the Tarmac and Trials Committees.
